Projects

I participated, as a guest expert, in the elaboration and support of the Social Network Analysis course, a discipline included in the Master's program in Information Analysis and Security Studies, developed since 2011 by the Faculty of Sociology and Social Work at the University of Bucharest , in partnership with the Romanian Intelligence Service.

I also participated, as a trainer, in the Strategic Project "Development of managerial skills of teaching staff with leadership, guidance and control functions in the pre-university system, in the knowledge society - OSCINT 2009", with funding from the European Social Fund and to the Government of Romania through POSDRU, carried out by the Ministry of Education, in partnership with the "Mihai Viteazul" National Academy of Intelligence. Within the project I held courses related to the field of information analysis.

I participated in the development of the SAFFRON project - Semantic Analysis against Foreign Fighters Recruitment Online Network, a European project co-financed by the Internal Security Fund of the European Union.

The aim of the SAFFRON project is to develop a system capable of supporting the early detection of recruitment processes by terrorist groups in Europe, with special attention being paid to the terrorist organizations ISIS and Al-Qaeda. The project focuses on studying the communication strategies used by terrorist organizations in the recruitment process in the virtual environment and on social networks (eg narratives, argumentative tropes, myths), as well as on revealing their evolution over time. The objectives of the project include analyzing the virtual communication strategies of terrorist groups and developing a social media campaign to counter terrorist propaganda.
