CEU Global Teaching Fellowship Program
provides short-term teaching opportunities
(one semester up to one academic year)
at Partner Universities for advanced
CEU and CIVICA doctoral candidates and recent
doctoral graduates

Eligibility

Doctoral candidates who:

- Are in their third year of PhD studies or beyond
- Have the endorsement of the supervisor and the doctoral school

Doctoral graduates who:

- Have received the Ph.D. within 2 years prior to application
- Some Calls for Applications require PhD graduates to apply

Stipend

- GTFP is co-financed by the Open Society University Network (OSUN) and local host institutions
- **Local salary:** most partners give fellows a local work contract with a basic salary with a similar amount to local lecturers in similar positions
- **GTFP-related Research Grant by CEU:** CEU subsidises the income with a Research Grant, which connects to the research a fellow is doing during the time of GTFP.

Stipend covers:

- One-time travel expenses
- Visa costs
- Health Insurance expenses
- Accommodation
- Living expenses

What do partner universities provide?

- A defined status for the Fellows (e.g. visiting fellow; assistant professor, etc.) with well specified rights and obligations
- A mentor for the Fellow at the host department (whenever possible)
- Integration into the larger academic community, and civic engagement
- Support regarding relocation, housing, cultural adjustment, etc. as needed

Calls for Applications

- General timeline:
 - To start teaching in the Fall semester
 - Calls announced around February
 - To start teaching in the Spring semester
 - Calls announced in October/November

Calls for applications are announced around the year

Application deadlines for teaching starting January/February 2023:

- **October 28, 2022**
- **November 11, 2022**

For teaching in AY 2023/2024: Calls for Applications will open in January 2023, with Deadlines in February.

Calls for Applications

Application materials should include the following for all applicants:

- motivation letter
- resume (CV)
- teaching philosophy (1,000 words)
- list of the desired course(s)

Additionally for Applicants who are CEU Ph.D. Candidates at the time of application:

- Endorsement letter from the Thesis Supervisor
- Endorsement letter from the Director of the Doctoral Program

Additionally for Applicants who are CEU Ph.D. graduates:

- One Academic Letter of Reference

Additional for CIVICA Application

- English language certificate – if Ph.D., not in English (check the relevant Call for Application)
 - for teaching in Budapest:
 - Research plan and timetable for double affiliation with CEU Democracy Institute

- Teaching Philosophy and Teaching Philosophy writing workshop
- Course preparation
- Syllabus writing
