[ 2025 ] **Social media repertoire. An analysis by age group**

In this article, we investigated how age influences social media behavior by analyzing the use of platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, and TikTok among five age groups. Based on photo-elicitation interviews, the research showed that young people use more platforms than older adults. Participants also prefer informative and useful content (e.g. religion, gastronomy), avoiding misinformation, indecent material, or material with a negative emotional impact. The study confirms the significant impact of age on social media use, while also suggesting the need to explore other demographic factors.
